- 1. <u>Dyson Airwrap</u> (\$600) Dyson makes greats products, including their vacuums. While it may be tempting to go the vacuum route, trust me, go Airwrap instead.
- 2. Hestan 5-Piece Cookware Set (\$800) Elevate your kitchen game.
- 3. Roomba Vacuum & Mop (\$1,300) This comes highly recommended from my buddy who always has the latest tech.
- 4. Herman Miller Gaming Chair (\$1,400) I work in gaming and I sit in a chair all day. This is the Rolls Royce of gaming chairs and I swear by it.
- 5. Of Rare Origin Bird Earrings (\$1,450) I'm told by someone very close to me that these are great.
- 6. One Wheel PintX (\$1,500) Cooler than it looks. Make sure you get a helmet.
- 7. **Brent Neale Bubble Necklace** (\$1,875) A very nice gift that you could consider if you need a 'push present' and want to use your child's initial.

- 2. <u>Holderness & Bourne Jacket</u> (\$275) I have splurged twice on a Holderness & Bourne, buying a jacket and pullover. Look good, play good?
- 3. <u>Remarkable</u> (\$300) It wasn't until it was recommended on Rambull by both Matias B and Will B on their Rambull profiles, I decided to pull the trigger. If you like the Kindle (another great gift idea), then you will be used to its screen and setup which doesn't have the blue light. I find it takes notes well, transfers to my computer easily, and has made my desk much more organized.
- 4. Artipoppe Baby Carrier (\$370) For all those trendy moms (and Dads) out there.

- 2. Shokz Open Run Headphones (\$130) Great technology that means nothing going inside your ear but instead over them. The sound and the mic quality has been just as good as AirPods. No brainer for runners.
- 3. Leatherman Arc Tool (\$230) The newest version of the iconic everything tool
- 4. The Everyday Backpack from Stubb & Co (\$150) Consultant traveler approved.
- 5. Fleece Lined Birkenstocks (\$160) Birkenstocks are BACK baby.
- 6. <u>Paldino Pro from Zafferano</u> (\$170) Cordless lamp, sounds lame but these are very useful and stylish (available at If Its Paper for those in Greensboro / Raleigh NC).
- 7. Matchbook Prints from Charles Ryan Clark (\$175) Several really good prints from iconic restaurants and universities. Great above the home bar or in the bathroom.

## \$50 to \$100




- 1. AirFly (\$50) For the frequent flyer, get a wireless connection from the audio jack.





- 9. Hands-Free Dog Leash (\$40) Perfect for the multi-tasking dog lovers.







